**Stawberry Banke Museum -** Step over the threshold of history ... into life in one of our country's oldest waterfront neighborhoods. Strawberry Banke is a 10-acre living history museum that has preserved the lifestyles and traditions of four centuries of New Englanders. Here you can see 40 buildings – most on their original sites – spanning from the late 1600s to the mid-1950s. From the sparce storefronts of colonial merchants to the elegant Georgian-style mansion of Governor Goodwin, from the humble dwellings of early Jewish immigrants to the penny candy counter of the WWII-era Abbott Store, Strawberry Banke tells the stories of a neighborhood over time.

Through trial and error, and more trial and error, a focus began to immerge. Flag Hill doesn't just make wines from their French-American, and Minnesota hybrid grapes, they also produce excellent fruit wines, a fortified wine, and they are now producing sparkling wines.
